

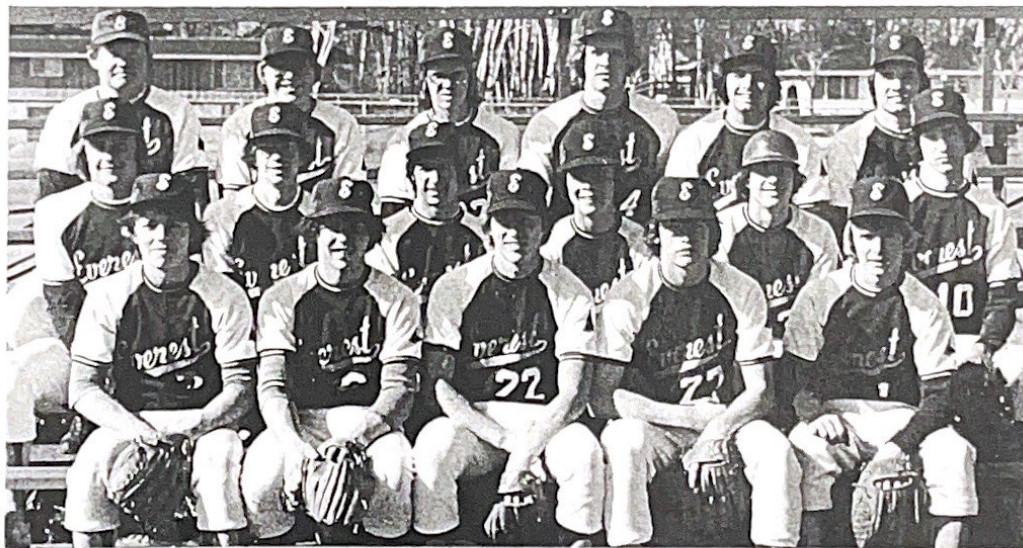
'The scores have been close'
